Town of St. George - Guidelines for Street Entertainer

Busking in Town of St. George

Street entertainment is commonly known as busking, and the performers are called buskers.

Buskers or street performers can be individuals or groups that play a musical instrument, sing, dance, juggle, mime, do magic or some other form of entertainment.

Buskers are not paid a fee for their performance and will not receive a pay cheque. Buskers receive their payment in the form of donations or tips from the crowds they entertain.

St. George's Permit Requirements

A Street Entertainment Permit is required for anyone performing in the Town streets or property. Groups are limited to three persons, and each individual member of the group must have a valid permit while performing.

Locations where busking is prohibited

- King Square between May 1 - Oct 31, 1 pm -4pm and when any event has been planned
- Pennos when there is an event planned
North of York Street

Busking conditions and guidelines

Buskers must comply with the following conditions and guidelines when busking in St. George's. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in fines, confiscation, suspension, or cancellation of your permit.

- A maximum of two performers per day is permitted along Water Street (west of King's Square) or York Street
- Maximum performance time is 60 minutes in one location. After 60 minutes you must move to a different location at least a full block away
- Performers and their audience must not block doorways, display windows, sidewalks, paths, or roads.
- Performances must not jeopardize the comfort and safety of others. Performers must respect the wishes of nearby residents and visitors, particularly regarding the loudness of the performance.
- The use of sharp or dangerous objects is prohibited, including juggling knives, hatchets, chainsaws, or flaming objects.
- Performers must cooperate immediately with requests by any member of the Police and Corporation of St. George's officials & staff
- Musicians are permitted to sell recordings of their original work during their performance. No other sales are permitted.
- In parks, performances may take place only during normal park hours while the park is open to the public and must end by 7:30pm. **Amplification is not permitted in town parks.**
- On city streets, performances may take place between 10:00am and 10:00pm, 7 days a week. **Amplification is not permitted on town streets.**
- Portrait artists may use one easel and two small folding chairs - additional easels and chairs require prior approval. The sale of pre-drawn work or photocopies is permitted.

Permit Fees

- Six-month permit (May - October) is \$50
- Annual permit is \$75

Permit Application

To apply for a Street Entertainment Permit, submit a completed application form in person with valid, current picture identification to the Corporation of St. George Office.
